

NATIONAL FORUM OF MUSIC ANNOUNCE AUDITIONS FOR THE POSITION OF THE 2ND CONCERTMASTER OF THE NFM LEOPOLDINUM ORCHESTRA

The auditions will be held on September 13, 2022, at 3 pm in the Chamber Hall of the National Forum of Music, pl. Wolności 1, Wrocław, Poland

Programme:

stage one

W.A. Mozart *Violin Concerto No 3 in G major* KV 216 (1st movement with cadenza and 2nd movement)

or

W.A. Mozart *Violin Concerto No 4 in D major* KV 218 (1st movement with cadenza and 2nd movement)

or

W.A. Mozart *Violin Concerto No 5 in A major* KV 219 (1st movement with cadenza and 2nd movement)

and

J.S. Bach: *Sonatas* or *Partitas* for solo violin – two contrasting movements or *Chaconne* from *Partita No. 2 in D minor* for solo violin BWV 1004

stage two

Violin concerto from the Romantic era or the 20th century, 1st movement (from L. van Beethoven to D. Shostakovich)

F. Mendelssohn *Octet in E flat major* op. 20, 1st movement
(candidate runs 15-20 minutes of rehearsal with orchestra members)

I. Stravinsky *Apollon musagète*, solo from *Variation d'Appollon*

G. Bacewicz *Concerto for String Orchestra*, 3rd movement

K. Szymanowski *Quartet for Orchestra* arr. R. Tognetti, 2nd movements

B. Britten – solo from *Prelude and Fugue* for string orchestra op. 29

E.W. Korngold *Sextet in D major* op. 10, *Intermezzo*

E. Grieg *Suite in Old Style "Aus Holberg Zeit"* op. 40, solo from *Rigaudon*

Important: candidates may be asked to play orchestral parts in each stage.

The NFM provides an accompanying pianist only on the audition day.

Details of the auditions schedule will be communicated to the candidates after the list of applicants has been closed.

GDPR clause:

- 3) the candidate's personal data will be processed in the recruitment process and conclusion of a possible contract, art. 6 sec. 1 lit. c GDPR (Regulation 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of personal data),
- 4) the candidate's personal data will be made available to third parties, if it will result from the provisions of applicable laws,
- 5) NFM does not intend to transfer the candidate's data to countries outside the European Economic Area (EEA),
- 6) the candidate's personal data will be processed during the recruitment and after its completion – for the time necessary, resulting from applicable law, but not longer than 3 months from the end of the recruitment,
- 7) the candidate has the right to request NFM to modify, delete or limit the processing of

personal data and to object to such processing,

8) the candidate has the right to submit a written, motivated request to cease data processing due to their special situation, as well as the right to object to the processing of data for purposes other than the above-mentioned purposes or to transferring them to another data administrator,
